But there are those times when you just can't make it to a Store. Or maybe you want to order a few passes ahead of time so you don't have to worry about it. 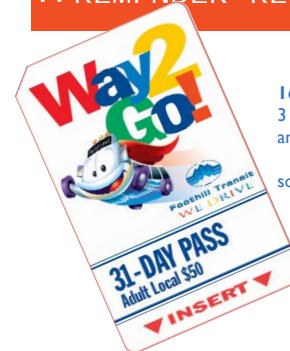
All orders online are still processed by our helpful

### NEW TRANSFER POLICY Effective July 1, 2005

Transfers are purchasable for \$0.50 when you pay your full fare.

Discount transfers for eligible seniors and persons with disabilities are available for \$0.25.

You can only use transfers once within the printed time and date, regardless of direction.

Foothill Transit transfers are worth the dollar value of the customer's local fare. Customers wishing to use a transfer to board Local Plus or Commuter Express service must pay the difference.

Local Plus Lines:	Transfer + \$2.00
Commuter Express Lines:	Transfer + \$2.50
For Senior/Disabled Local Plus Lines:	Transfer + \$1.00
For Senior/Disabled Commuter Express Lines:	Transfer + \$1.25

Monthly passes and tickets from Metrolink and transfers from Los Angeles Metro are good for one boarding on local Foothill Transit buses. Customers wishing to board Local Plus or Commuter Express service must pay the difference.

Foothill Transit transfers are also accepted by Los Angeles Metro.

#### OCTA and Omnitrans Policy:

Monthly passes, day passes, and transfers from OmniTrans and OCTA are accepted as one Adult Local Fare at the following locations:

OmniTrans bus at Indian Hill Blvd. and Holt Ave.  
OmniTrans bus at Montclair Transcenter  
OmniTrans bus at Pomona TransCenter  
OCTA bus at Beach and La Habra.

Customers wishing to board Local Plus or Commuter Express service must pay the difference.

Summer is becoming a real gas at Foothill Transit.

Not only has our Irwindale Facility gone live with a new compressed natural gas (CNG) fueling station, but the Executive Board just approved the purchase of another 42 CNG buses from North American Bus Industries. Ok, everyone, deep breath in...and exhale. Smell that? No? Good. That's what cleaner air is supposed to smell like.

With the addition of 75 new CNG buses to the fleet in 2004, we bumped our alternative fuel vehicle percentage to over 60 percent. Considering that these new 2005 vehicles will bump our count to 234 CNG buses (out of a total of 306 buses in our fleet), we're way ahead of schedule on our goal to convert our entire fleet over to alternative fuels by 2010. In fact, chances are you're probably sitting in one of our CNG buses right now.

Changing our fleet over to alternative fuels is just one part of the clean air equation. The other one is convincing people to step out of their cars and into the bus. And if you are reading this, you're likely already one of the converted. So while we're busy enjoying the CNG fruits of our labor, we hope you'll take the time to encourage your coworkers
